- 2) The Son Jesus is Yahweh God
 - A) In the Old Testament
 - a) The Messenger of Yahweh is mentioned 56 times in the OT. He is called Yahweh Himself (Genesis 16:9–13, Judges 6:12–19, He is called God (Genesis 16:9–13, Numbers 22:35–38) He is sacrificed to (Genesis 22:10–14, Judges 6:12–19)
 - b) The Promised Messiah was to be Yahweh come to Earth.

Micah 5:2, Jeremiah 23:5-6, Psalm 45:6-7, Isaiah 9:6-7

- c) Prophesies about Yahweh are applied to Jesus
 - 1) "they will look on Me whom they have pierced" (Zech. 12:8-10, Jn 19:33-37
 - 2) "A voice is calling, 'Clear the way for Yahweh'" (Is. 40:1-5, Jn. 1:23-31)
- 3) The Son Jesus is Yahweh God
 - A) In the Old Testament
 - a) The Messenger of Yahweh is mentioned 56x

 - c) Prophesies about Yahweh are applied to Jesus
 - B) In the New Testament
 - a) The Gospel of John introduces Jesus as the eternal God come to earth.
 - b) John the Baptist announces <u>Jesus</u> as Yahweh come to earth.
 - c) Jesus claims to be Yahweh calling Himself the "I AM".
 - d) Jesus receives and accepts worship.
 - e) Jesus' self-claims are the <u>foundation</u> of Paul's Christology.
